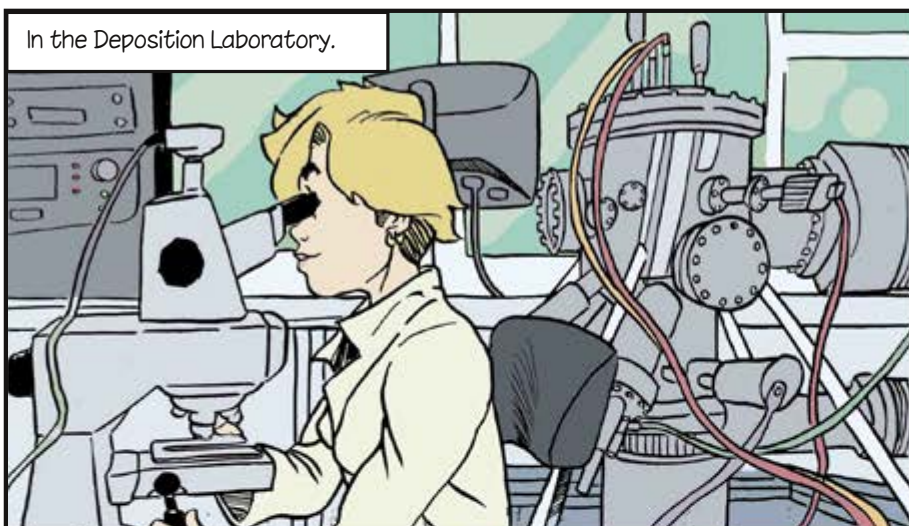
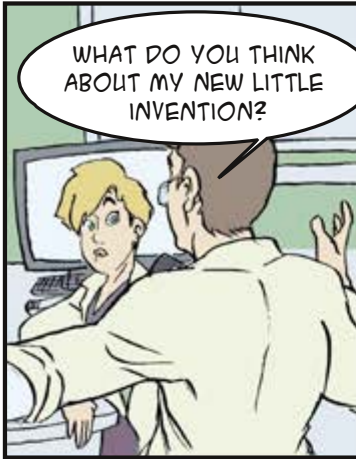


BACK TO THE ORIGINS
